

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Submission and evaluation of a contribution

1.1. SENDING OF SUBMISSION PROPOSAL

Manuscripts should be sent electronically to the following address:
revuejuridiquedubonheur@oib-france.com

They can be sent spontaneously by authors for publications outside thematic issues, responding to calls for contributions published on the review's website or on request. All submissions follow the same evaluation procedure and must comply with the recommendations defined in this document.

The manuscript should not exceed 60,000 characters (spaces included) unless otherwise specified. Articles must be written in French, English or Spanish.

Texts and documents should be delivered in Word formats for texts and tables. The original files of the illustrations should be delivered, together with the text, in JPG format (at 300 dpi for photographs).

1.2. SELECTION OF CONTRIBUTIONS

The Review only publishes original contributions that have not been published previously. Articles sent are evaluated blindly by two members of the editorial committee or by external experts, if necessary.

The evaluation criteria relate to content and form. The final decision is made by the editorial director after consultation of the evaluators. It is sent to the author as soon as possible. In the case of acceptance of publication with corrections, the author is notified a period of time to send the corrected version. Submissions accepted for publication subject to major modifications may be subject to a second internal evaluation. The editorial committee can decide not to publish the submission if the required corrections have not been made.

1.3. CESSION OF RIGHTS

Authors who submit their articles to the Review agree to publish their articles free of charge. They transfer, free of charge and not exclusively, the paper and electronic distribution rights which allow the free and open distribution of the journal.

The authors retain the right to distribute, in any manner, the articles published in the Review on the only condition, as required by law, that complete bibliographic references appears, mentioning the Review. In particular, authors can deposit the published version, in full text, in academic databases.

2. Presentation of the contribution

2.1.CHARACTER FONT

The font used should be Times or Times New Roman, size 12.

Italics should be used for foreign words and for titles of books or periodicals. Bold should be reserved for titles and subtitles. The underline is to be avoided.

2.2.STRUCTURATION OF THE CONTRIBUTION

Texts should be structured as follow:

- Title
- Surname, Name
- Affiliation; function; email address ; site
- Abstract
- Keywords
- Title translated (in French and/or Spanish): *if possible*
- Abstract translated (in French and/or Spanish): *if possible*
- Keywords translated
- Introduction

2.3.BIBLIOGRAPHIC REFERENCES

Bibliographic references and other references should appear in footnotes. A full bibliography should be placed at the end of the contribution.

3. Bibliography

Bibliographic references should be gathered at the end of the paper. They should include all the references mentioned in the contribution.

They should be presented as follow:

3.1. BOOKS

Individual Book

Complete Name, initials of surname of first author. and initial of surname. complete name of following author (year). *Title in italic*, Town of edition, Editor, Collection.

Collective Book

Complete Name, initials of surname of first director. and initial of surname. complete name of following director (dir.) (year). *Title in italic*, Town of edition, Editor, Collection.

3.2. PAPERS PUBLISHED IN JOURNALS

Paper published in paper journalr

Complete Name, initials of surname of first author. and initial of surname. complete name of following author (year). "Title of the paper", *Name of the Journal in italic*, volume (number of the journal) : pages.

Complete Name, initials of surname of first author. and initial of surname. complete name of following author (year). "Title of the paper", *Name of the Journal in italic*, URL : <site of the journal>, number of the journal.

3.3. BOOK CHAPTERS

Complete Name, initials of surname of first author. and initial of surname. complete name of following author (year). "Title of the paper", in initials and name of author(s) of book (dir.), *Name of the book in italic*, Town of edition, Editor, Collection.

3.4. RELATED DOCUMENTS (TABLES, IMAGES, PHOTOGRAPHIES...)

All related documents should be numeroted and called in the text. Their exact localisation within the text should be precised. They should be sent in original format and their location should be specified in the text.

Each document should be accompanied of :

- A short title;
- The name(s) of their author(s) ;
- Sources (Family Name of the author, initial of the surname, year of publication and page; Legend if any.

Submissions that do not meet the standards defined above will be returned to their author without being submitted for evaluation.
